There are two Cycle Races through Esher on Sunday 2nd August.

Prudential RideLondon-Surrey 100

25,000 amateur cyclists will take on a 100-mile cycle challenge through the closed roads of London and Surrey before finishing in the Mall.

Prudential RideLondon-Surrey Classic

-the world's best male cyclists will compete in this world-class race through London before heading into Surrey and returning to London to finish in the Mall.

The following Roads will be closed from **7.30 a.m. to 19.00 p.m.**

Copsem Lane
Claremont Lane
High Street
Portsmouth Road

Note these roads will start to be closed from 5.00 a.m. as all barriers etc must be in place by 7.30 a.m.

The **A3** will be open all day, although the junctions at **Esher Common**, Coombe Lane and Tibbet's Corner will be closed. The M25 is open as normal.
