Some of our roads in Esher and Hersham are in a shocking state. They will deteriorate further unless Surrey County Council is forced to act far more promptly and make more durable repairs.

Investigate ways to improve parking provision to help our residents and High Street businesses:

Create innovative parking schemes that better meet the needs of our residents' changed lives and working patterns post Covid and also benefit our valuable High Street businesses.

We are part of Elmbridge Residents Group - shaping the vision of Elmbridge Borough Council

The ERG is the largest group in Council, forming a dynamic non-political Residents Association-led administration.

ERG priorities:

- A sensible, prudent budget that will help reduce our use of reserves as we build back from two years of pandemic.
- Services for the community we continue to provide a comprehensive range of services for young and old: Meals on Wheels, sport and recreation, seven Community Centres, a Youth Hub, community transport and many more.
- Keep Council tax rises below inflation Elmbridge increased its share of council tax by 2.16%, in contrast to Conservative-led Surrey County Council's 4.99%.
- An original, visionary Local Plan we have shaped the Local Plan so that the final version: preserves all our Green Belt and reduces, by over 25%, the untenable housing target the Government tried to impose on us.
- · Provides for housing that is more affordable.
- Ensures future building will be to standards that lead us towards Net Zero Carbon
