

Historic Esher Place: redevelopment for expensive flats.

Refused by Elmbridge Borough Council and the Government Inspector after a strong campaign by the ERA, supporting local residents.

**Esher Theatre:** the ERA were at the forefront of establishing this vibrant new asset to the town and borough.

<u>Blue Plaques</u>: the ERA initiative set up in 2010 has honoured a number of prestigious residents from Francis Williamson, Queen Victoria's favourite sculptor, to Beatle George Harrison and John Cobb, the 'fastest man on Earth'.

#### The fight goes on...

**Hersham Golf Course**: redevelopment of 221 units on Green Belt. The ERA is working closely with the Hersham Village Society against this development..

**Moore Place Golf Course:** redevelopment of 300 units. Yet more Green Belt that is potentially under threat from developers who have shut the golf course.

<u>Change Esher plan</u>: we are delighted that our current MP has taken on board the ERA's plans to improve the roads infrastructure surrounding Esher. Obviously, this is at an early stage, but we hope his successor will not abandon this much needed initiative.

Oyster card Zone 6 Extension: we are also delighted that, despite initially giving us a definite 'no can do', our current MP has now taken on board the ERA's suggestion to improve the ease of rail access to London.

<u>Hersham Village Shopping Centre re-development</u>: working with the Hersham Village Society and the Hersham Residents Association to oppose a disastrous scheme that will have a serious impact on the residents of Hersham and Esher.

**Elmbridge Civic Centre:** this inefficient and underused prime site in the centre of Esher is to be redeveloped and we will work to ensure that any plans fit the needs of our residents and businesses.
